

WHO IS THE SCHEME FOR?

The Aboriginal Study Grants Scheme (ABSTUDY) helps Aborigines and Torres Strait Islanders who have left school and want to study.

WHAT KIND OF STUDY?

We can help you with just about any kind of study. It can be a long course or a short one, full-time, part-time or by correspondence. It depends on what you want to do.

- You may wish to study at a
 Teachers' College
 Business College
 Technical College
 College of Advanced Education
 University
- or do secondary studies, if you left school some time ago and now want to finish your schooling
- or we can set up a course specially for you, near where you live, in almost anything you want to learn.

WHAT IS PAID?

Full-time study

You get a **living allowance** of \$57.27 a week if you are 18 years or over, or are married or have children. If you are under 18, you get \$47.25 a week. There is an additional living allowance of \$5.25 a week paid to unmarried students under 25.

There is a **dependants allowance** paid for each person dependent on you.

There are establishment and clothing allowances to help you meet costs at the time you start your course. The amount paid depends on the length of your course, and whether you need to live away from home.

The textbooks and equipment needed for your course can be paid for by the **textbook** and equipment allowance.

If you have to live away from home to study, the scheme will meet your beginning and end-of-term **travel costs**. If you are married, and have to live away from home to study, the scheme will pay fares for your husband or wife and your children if they go with you, at the beginning and end of each year of your course.

If you are having problems with your study and need some extra help, we can arrange for **tutorial assistance**.

We pay all your compulsory fees.

Part-time study

You get an allowance of \$3 a week or \$6 a week, depending on the number of hours you spend in class.
