The aboriginals will be responsible for their own maintenance and the full amount of pension will be paid to them by means of a group cheque to the Deputy Director of Native Affairs, Thursday Island. Subject: Payment of Pensions to Aboriginal Natives - Former residents of

Mapoon Mission.

Reference: Your P4/387(2)/LMcT of 22nd July, 1963.

Thank you for your advice on the transfer of aboriginal pensioners to New Mapoon near Bamaga.

It is noted that pensions for the eligible people will be paid by group cheque to the Deputy Director of Native Affairs, Thursday Island. What we would like to know is whether it is then proposed that the whole amount of each individual pension will then be paid to the aboriginal concerned in cash, or whether some (and, if so, much) will be paid into the pensioners' trust accounts.

We would also be interested to know the position in regard to the payment of pensions for other pensioners at Bamaga.
